

We are changing the way we manage neonatal early onset infection



Our trust will be adopting a new method for managing infection in newborns. For babies requiring a prolonged course of antibiotics, the new pathway allows for a switch from IV to oral antibiotics at 36 hours of age if certain criteria are met.
